## Sangeeta Barthakur

Born : 16-7-1963

Death : 8-3-2016

The College witnessed the most mournful day on 8th March 2016, with the death of professor Sangeeta Barthakur, Head of the Deptt. of Economics. It was a great loss for the deptt. and College as she was one of the most active and vibrant lady of the college.

Her bright eyes and pleasing personality made her to be the most friendly and of loving nature. Her presence will always be felt and with heart's heaviness and painful tears we bade her farewell to rest her soul in eternal peace and tranquility.

It was in the evening that the college received the news of the sad demise of Sangeeta Barthakur (HOD, Economics). A pall of gloom set in whole college. Baideo's body was brought to the college, students, teachers, office/ library staff paid their last respects. Baideo fought for fifteen whole days in Nemcare Hospital after her saree caught fire while paying her deep obseiance to the Almighty at Hanuman Mandir, near FCI. The college also arranged a prayer meeting with the chantings of shlokas and reading extracts by the religious leaders of Sikh, Buddhist, Islam and Christians.

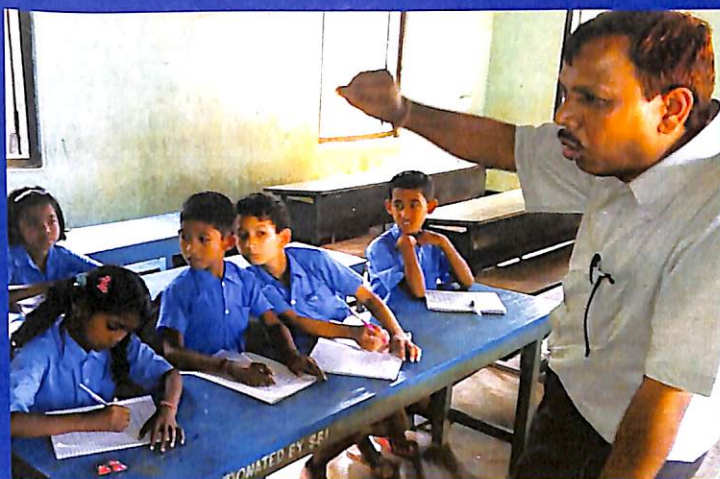
