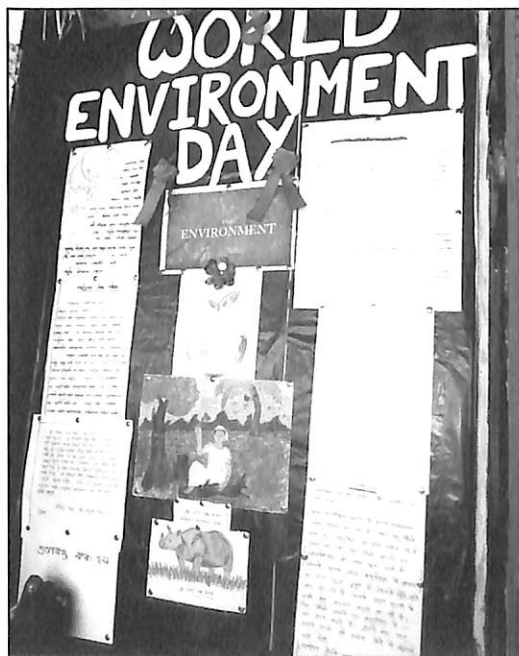
Environment Day was celebrated by planting sapling and preparing a wall magazine an environment.

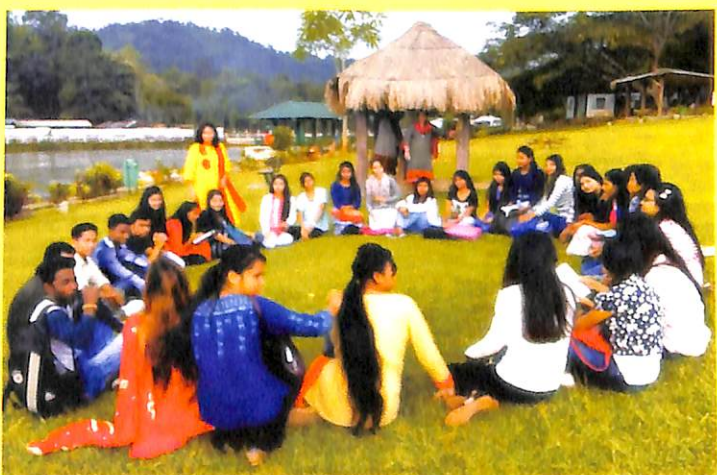
