

INTRODUCTION:

Narangi Anchalik Mahavidyalaya, a leading institute of higher education was established in the year 1991 solely at the initiative of the people of greater Narangi area. The college, located at the easternmost part of the city of Guwahati, has come a long way in providing and spreading higher education amongst ethnic and linguistic groups. Today the college takes pride in having moulded many citizens of high repute, established in different fields like literature, teaching, administration, journalism, music and culture etc. At the eve of celebrating the Silver Jubilee of its existence, the college feels confident on its today and is hopeful of the future. Today the college family feels proud while looking back to the history of its growth.

The College initially started its classes in the evening shift at Narangi high School on 2nd September, 1991. However, within a few months, the college was shifted to its own permanent site in a beautiful spacious compound surrounded by green hillocks. The college has at present, required number of classrooms, a well-stocked library with reading room, separate common rooms for teachers, boys and girls, departmental rooms and office-room for the students' union. The new four storied building which homes the rich library, laboratory and the department of Geography along with the office of the Principal renders completeness to the college. Behind the rapid growth of the College as a premier seat of higher education lies the selfless and enthusiastic commitment of the people of greater Narengi area whose hopeful relentless support have paved the way of its success. With the co-ordinated effort of the Governing Body and the highly qualified teachers, the college has now developed into a full-fledged institution providing an excellent studying environment. GENERAL RULES

- **1.** A student shall lose her/his right of Admission to her/his class, if s/he fails to attend his/her classes continuously for 15 teaching days from the date of the commencement of classes.
- 2. The courses of study in Narangi Anchalik Mahavidyalaya are full time courses. No student can take any other full time course concurrently. If any student is admitted to any other course, then the student/guardian should inform the college authority immediately and discontinue the other course if s/he wants to continue the course at this college. Violation to this provision will lead to disciplinary action.
- **3.** If a newly admitted student of HS first year or TDC first semester fails to attend classes within 15 days from the commencement of classes, s/he will forfeit her/his seat.

- **4.** Students are responsible for their conduct to the Principal are prohibited from doing anything either inside or outside the college, that amounts to breach of discipline or interference in the discipline and normal working of the college. Students shall be liable to disciplinary action for violation of any of the rules of discipline. Disciplinary action may involve warning and/ or fine, and/or suspension from classes, from the examination, from the use of the college library or even from the college as such.
- **5.** Students shall conduct themselves in decorous manner both towards members of the staff (Teaching and Administrative) and towards their fellow students. Insubordination, unbecoming language or indecorous conduct including teasing, ragging, assaulting others, etc. shall be severely dealt with.
- **6.** Students shall maintain perfect silence in the classroom, reading room and in the common room and desist from demonstration or disorderly behaviour. They must not loiter in the corridor or in front of the classroom and must keep as quite as possible at all times.
- **7.** Students shall take proper care of the college property, furniture and premises and they must not spoil or cause any damage to, or tamper with the college property, furniture and fittings. They shall not litter the college campus.
- **8.** Students shall leave their bicycles, scooter/motorcycles locked in the shed provided for that purpose. No two-wheelers should be parked in any other part of the college campus or in front of the college campus.
- **9.** No Society can be formed in the college without the permission of the Principal, nor shall any person be invited to address a meeting in the college without prior permission of the college authority.
- 10. No notice can be circulated/pasted inside the college without prior permission of the Principal.
- 11. Students shall not bring any article deemed by the college authority to have a dangerous and/or disruptive influence on the academic environment. Use of Cell phones is strictly prohibited inside the college campus. Students who fail to switch off their Cell phones inside class will have to pay a fine of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred only). Students found in possession of Cell phones inside the examination hall are liable to be expelled.
- **12.** Use of any tobacco product and alcoholic drinks/beverages is strictly prohibited inside the college campus and violators will be penalized with a fine and/or rustication.
- 13. All students will be required to attend the classes, examinations and other activities held inside the college campus in College UNIFORM.

Leave and Attendance Rules: For B.A./B.Com. Semester Programme & H.S. Programme

- 1.7% per Semester leave for participation in NCC Camps, Debates, Quiz, Sports, Cultural Programmes, etc. will be granted as per College Guidelines. Prior intimation for leave for such activities will have to be submitted to the Vice Principal.
- $\textbf{2.} \ \ \text{Members of the College Team participating in the Inter College Competitions will be granted 10\% attendance if they fail to fulfill the required attendance of 75\%.}$
- $\textbf{3.} \, \text{Members of the Narangi Anchalik Mahavidyalaya Students Union will be granted 10\% attendance if they fail to fulfill the required 75\% attendance due to their engagements in Union related activities.}$
- **4.** Students will be granted 15% attendance on medical ground. Students applying for medical leave will have to submit a medical certificate issued by a Govt. Doctor along with the application. The Application must be addressed to the Principal and submitted to the Vice Principal within a week of his/her joining his/her class.

- **5.** Students attending less than 60% of total classes held in a Semester (in case of B.A. and B.Com.)/a Year (in case of H.S.) will be treated as discollegiate and will be barred from appearing in the Final examinations of the University/AHSEC.
- **6.** Attendance in the previous Year (for H.S. programme) or previous Semester(s) (for T.D.C. programme) will not be taken into account in the subsequent Year or Semesters.
- 7. Expulsion from any examination will lead to the expulsion from the college.

UNIFORM: All students are required to attend all the College activities in UNIFORM as given below:

Boys': White Shirts with gray collar and calves and Gray Pant.

Winter wear- Gray Sweater/Blazer.

Girls': White Mekhela and Chaddar with Whitish Pink Border and Whitish Pink Blouse or Dark Pink Salwar & Whitish Pink Kurta with Dark Pink Dupatta.

Winter wear- Whitish Pink Sweater/Blazer

ANTI RAGGING SQUAD

UGC GUIDELINE FOR PREVENTING RAGGING

Aper the UGC Guideline No. F 1-16/2007 (CPP-II), April, 2009, all forms of ragging in hostels and college campuse are prohibited. Ragging is considered as a cognizable offence under the law of the land and raging in all its forms is totally banned in the entire institution, including its departments, constituent units, al its premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen etc.) whether located within the campus or outside and in al means of transportation of students whether public or private. Punishable ingredients of Ragging are (i) Abetment of ragging; (ii) Criminal conspiracy to rag; (iii) Unlawful assembly and rioting while raging; (iv) Public nuisance created during raging; (v) Violations of decency and morals through raging; (vi) Injury to body causing hurt or grievous hurt; (vii) Wrongful restraint; (viii) Wrongful confinement; (ix) Use of criminal force; (x) Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences; (xi) Extortion; (xii) Criminal trespass; (xiii) Offences against property; (xiv) Criminal intimidation; (xv) tempt to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against victim; (xvi) Physical or psychological humiliation; (xvii) All other offences following the definition of "Ragging".

The College has an Anti-Ragging Squad comprised of teachers and the members of the Students Union to check any possible occurrence of ragging in the Campus. Based on the suggestions and recommendations of the Squad, the following disciplinary actions may be taken by the Disciplinary Committee of the College if anyone found involved in ragging both directly and indirectly.

PROGRAMMES OF STUDY AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The academic session commences from August. The college at present offers wide varieties of courses under the programmes mentioned below. Application for admission to the college should be made in prescribed admission forms available along with the prospectus on payment of Rs. 150/- at the College Office or by sending a request accompanied by a stamped self addressed envelope along with an IPO of Rs. 150/- drawn in favour of "PRINCIPAL, NARANGI ANCHALIK MAHAVIDYALAYA, P. O. NARENGI, GUWAHATI-781171" or a bank demand draft drawn in favour of "PRINCIPAL, NARANGI ANCHALIK MAHAVIDYALAYA". The dates of admission of various programmes will be notified after announcement of the results of HSLC and HSSLC examinations

- 2. Higher Secondary Commerce (Self Supportive)
- 3. Three Years Degree Programme in Arts
- 4. Three Years Degree Programme in Commerce (Self Supportive)

The following documents must be produced at the time of admission

- Original Marksheet, Pass Certificate Registration Certificate of the last qualifying 1. examination
- Certificate of the Head of the Institution last attended 2.
- Two copies of recent passport size photographs 3.
- Original Caste Certificate (issued by District Administrative Authority, viz. DC/SDC) 4. for admission against caste quota. Provisional certificates will not be considered
- Proficiency Certificate of extra-curricular activities 5.
- 6. Students who have passed the qualifying examination earlier than the current session need to submit a gap certificate for the period from the Head of the Institution last attended.

Admission to the College is strictly on merit. No application will be accepted after the stipulated last date of submission unless the College authority extends the last date for the same. All admissions to the College are provisional and subject to the approval of the Gauhati University/ Assam Higher Secondary Education Council. The College shall not be held responsible for GU/AHSEC not approving the admission of the student on various grounds such as not producing the migration certificate, eligibility certificate or furnishing false statements or the likes. The College shall not be held responsible for the problems in registration procedure in GU/AHSEC due to delay in submission of application forms on part of the student.

N. B. Maximum intake per subject is 150 students. Seats will be filled in on first come first serve basis and no student will be allowed to take up a subject after all the seats of that subject are filled.

Admission of Unsuccessful Candidates:

- H. S. 1st Year and T. D. C. (1st and 2nd semesters) students detained during Pre-final/Test Examination or declared discollegiate need to apply for admission along with the fresh applicants. However, no preference may be availed by such candidates in respect to admission to the College.
- Students detained in the same class for two consecutive years in H. S. and three consecutive years in T. D. C. programmes will not be eligible for admission to the regular programmes in the College.

The unsuccessful candidates of T.D.C. (1st and 2nd Semesters) & (3rd and 4th Semesters) Examinations of Gauhati University appearing from the College need to enroll their names as regular students of T.D.C. 3rd and 4th Semesters) & (5th and 6th Semester) classes respectively as notified by the College Authority.

Academic Session :: 2015-2016

Semester System is an innovative approach to teaching-learning process, an educational culture, a student-friendly system, which requires a new mindset in the part of the learners as well as the facilitators of learning.

The UGC vide its circular No. D.O. No. F.I-2/2008 dated March 2009 under the new initiatives for academic reforms under XI plan that the Universities shall have to take necessary action in order to introduce Semester System at the under graduate level by 2012.

Following the UGC recommendation Gauhati University has introduced the Semester System in the three year degree courses across the streams in the colleges under it. This has come into effect from the 2011-2012 Academic Session. The Semester System is of three years duration distributed in six semesters.

*1st, 3rd and 5th Semester : Odd Semester

August 1 - December 31

 $^*2^{nd}$, 4^{th} and 6^{th} Semester : Even Semester

January 1-June 30

Admission Notice and Criteria:

Newspaper notice inviting applications for admission into different programmes shall be issued by the Principals of the colleges/institutes as per the Academic Calendar of the University. The admission criteria shall be fixed by the Academic Council from time to time whenever necessary. The college/institutes may also adopt their own policy for admission or selection of eligible candidates for admission complying with the eligibility criteria prescribed by the University.

Examination and Evaluation:

- a) Examination and Evaluation shall be done on a continuous basis and in accordance with the routine and academic calendar and at least two times during each semester.
- b) Final examinations of TDC under Semester System will be held as per the notifications of Gauhati University.
- c) Final examinations of 10+2 classes will be held as per the notifications of AHSEC.
- d) There shall be 20% marks for internal assessment and 80% marks for End-Semester examination in each course during every semester in TDC. The marks allotted for internal evaluation (20%) shall be based on the following:
 - i. Sessional Examination I
 - ii. Sessional Examination II
 - iii. Home assignment, Seminars, and Group Discussions, or related work depending on the decision of the techer/college concerned.
 - Home assignment (as in Sub-article No. iii under Article d) etc. may be given to the student at any time during the semester. Each such assignment may be regarded as one question out of four in each sessional examination and that total internal marks in i-iii above should be 20% of the marks allotted to the paper.
- e) There shall be no provision for re-evaluation of the answer scripts of the end-semester examinations. However, a candidate may apply for re-scrutiny. However, if a student misses the examination(s) on valid ground (proper supporting documents should be produced) then the teacher/college concerned may allow the student separate examination(s) using the teacher's own discretion.
- f) Each sessional examination shall be of one hour duration and be conducted by the concerned teacher of each paper. The students shall write the examination in proper University answer books. The setting of question paper, invigilation duty, evaluation of answer scripts for each paper shall be done by the concerned teacher(s) as part of his/her/their normal duty. The teacher(s) concerned shall fix the exact date of the sessional examination following the guidelines of the academic schedule.
- g) After evaluation, the answer scripts should be shown to the students and necessary corrective measures should be prescribed if there are any. Afterwards the answerscripts should be collected back. The entire process shall not take more than two weeks from the date of the examination.
- h) There shall be one end semester examination carrying 80% Marks in each course of a semester covering the entire syllabus prescribed for the course.
- i) Setting of question papers, moderation of question papers, evaluation of answer scripts, scrutiny, tabulation of marks etc. and announcement of results shall be governed by the Gauhati University Examination Ordinance (as amended upto date).
- j) Practical Examination of a Semester shall be held prior to the End Semester Examinations. No betterment shall be allowed in the Practical Examinations.
- k) A candidate shall be declared passed a semester provided s/he passes all the courses of a semester independently.
- 1) A candidate shall be entitled to a maximum of three chances to clear a course.
- m) If a candidate clears the sixth semester examination before clearing all the courses of the previous semester(s), the result of the sixth semester examination of that candidate shall be withheld till s/he clears the course of the previous semester(s).
- n) A student must pass all her/his semester examinations within FIVE (5) years from the date of admission to the First Semester of any programme.

o) Since the Semester System involves continuous assessment, there shall be no scope for a student to appear as a private candidate in any programme in this system.

A student who has less than 75% attendance (in theory and practical as applicable) shall not be permitted to sit for the end-semester examination in the course in which the shortfall exists.

LIBRARY RULES

All the students of the college are members of the college library by virtue of the library fees they pay along with the tuition fees. Every student using the library will be given library cards in the following manner:

H. S. and Degree (Core) – 01

Degree Major Courses - 02

Students will be entitled to keep books for **two weeks**, i. e., fourteen days from the date of issue and it shall be returned to the library at the end of the period. There is provision of re-issue of the same book to the same person if it is not wanted by someone else in which case the book may be retained for a period of another one week. The librarian may recall a book at any time. A student failing to return a book on due date will be levied a fine of Rs. 1/- per book for each consecutive day beyond the due date.

A student who wishes to borrow a book shall fill in a lending slip which will be provided at the counter of the library free of cost and present it at the issue counter along with the library card.

A student is not entitled to borrow a book against the library card of another person. If detected, s/he will be punished and/or fined.

Final Year/ Semester students must return their library books along with the library cards before collecting their Admit Card of the final examination.

Strict silence and decorum should be maintained in the library. Students shall have to **switch-off** their mobile phones while at the library. Books have to be replaced if lost or damaged. Students found mutilating library books or periodicals or journals or magazines will be subject to disciplinary action. The College Library is open on all the working days of the college from 10:00 a.m. to 04:00 p.m.

Scholars are required to observe strict discipline and also be regular in class attendance and maintaining sound academic performance during the scholarship period, failing which their scholarship may be withdrawn.


