






There is a students' Union in the College. This is an elected Body which organizes and promotes cultural and sports activities in the College. Secretaries elected by the students manage union functions under the guidance of the Union President and Teacher-in-charge appointed by the Principal.

GENERAL RULES

1. A student shall lose her/his right of admission to her/his class, if he/she fails to attend his/her classes continuously for 15 teaching days from the date of commencement of classes.
2. The Course of study in Narangi Anchalik Mahavidyalaya are full time courses. No student can take any other full time course concurrently. Violation to this provision will lead to disciplinary action.

3. If a newly admitted student to HS first year or TDC first semester fails to attend classes within 15 days from the commencement of classes, he/she will forfeit his/her seat.
4. Students are responsible for their conduct to the principal and are prohibited from doing anything either inside or outside the College, that amounts to breach of discipline. Students shall be liable to disciplinary action for violation of any of the rules of discipline. Disciplinary action may involve warning and /or fine, and/or suspension from classes, from the examination, from the use of the college library or even from the college as such.
5. Students shall conduct themselves in decorous manner both towards members of the staff (Teaching and administrative) and towards their fellow students. Insubordination, unbecoming language or indecorous conduct including teasing, ragging, assaulting others, etc. shall be severely dealt with.
6. Students shall maintain perfect silence in the classroom, reading room and in the common room and desist from demonstration or disorderly behavior. They must not loiter in the corridor or in front of the classroom and must keep as quiet as possible at all time.
7. Student shall take proper care of the college property, furniture and premises and they must not spoil or cause any damage to, or temper with the college property, furniture and fittings. They shall not loiter the college campus.
8. Students shall leave their bicycles, scooter/motorcycle locked in the shed provided for that purpose. No two-wheelers should be parked in any other part of the college campus or in front of the college campus.
9. No Society can be formed in the college without the permission of the Principal, nor shall any person be invited to address a meeting in the college without prior permission of the college authority.
10. No Notice can be circulated/pasted inside the college without prior permission of the Principal.
11. Students shall not bring any article deemed by the college authority to have a dangerous and/or disruptive influence on the academic environment. Use of cell phones is strictly prohibited inside the college campus. Students who fail to switch off their Cell Phones inside class will have to pay a fine of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred only). Students found in possession of cell phones inside the examination hall are liable to be expelled.
12. Use of any tobacco product and alcoholic drinks/beverages is strictly prohibited inside the college campus and violators will be penalized with a fine and/or rustication.
13. All students will be required to attend the classes, examination and other activities held inside the college campus in College UNIFORM.

Level and Attendance Rules: For B.A. Semester Programme & H.S. Programme.

1. 7% per Semester leave for participation in NCC Camps, Debates, Quiz, Sports, Cultural Programmes, etc. will be granted as per College Guidelines. Prior intimation for such activities will have to be submitted to the Vice-Principal.
2. Members of the College Team participating in the inter College Competitions will be granted 10% attendance if they fail to fulfill the required attendance of 75%.

3. Members of the Narangi Anchalik Mahavidyalaya Students Union will be granted 10% attendance if they fail to fulfill the required 75% attendance due to their engagements in Union related activities.
4. Students will be granted 15% attendance on medical ground. Students applying for medical leave will have to submit a medical certificate issued by a Govt. Doctor along with application. The Application must be addressed to the Principal and submitted to the Vice Principal within a week of his/her joining his/her class.
5. Students attending less than 60% of total classes will be treated as discollegiate and will be barred from appearing in the Final Examinations of the University/AHSEC.
6. Attendance in the previous Year (for H.S. Programme) or previous Semester(s) (for T.D.C. Programme) will not be taken into account in the subsequent Year or Semesters.
7. Expulsion from any examination will lead to the expulsion from the college.

UNIFORM: All Students are required to attend all the College activities in UNIFORM as given below:

Winter wear – Grey Sweater/Blazer.

Winter wear – Whitish Pink Sweater/Blazer.

ANTI-RAGGING SQUAD

UGC GUIDELINES FOR ANTI-RAGGING

As per the UGC Guideline No. F1-16/2007 (CPP – II), April, 2009, all forms of ragging in hostels and college campus are prohibited. Ragging is considered as a cognizable offence under the law of the land and ragging in all its forms is totally banned in the entire institution, including its departments, constituent units, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen etc.) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private. Punishable ingredients of Ragging are (i) Abetment of ragging; (ii) Criminal conspiracy to rag; (iii) Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging; (iv) Public nuisance created during ragging; (v) Violations of decency and morals through ragging; (vi) Injuring to body causing hurt or grievous hurt; (vii) Wrongful restraint; (viii) Wrongful confinement; (ix) Use of criminal force; (x) assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences; (xi) Extortion; (xii) Criminal trespass; (xiii) Offences against property; (xiv) Criminal intimidation; (xv) tempt to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against victim; (xvi) Physical or psychological humiliation; (xvii) All other offences following the definition “Ragging”

The College has an Anti-Ragging Squad comprising of teachers and the members of the Students Union to check any possible occurrence of ragging in the Campus. Based on the suggestions and recommendations of the Squad, the following disciplinary actions may be taken by the Disciplinary Committee of the College :

1. Suspension from attending classes
2. With holding scholarship, fellowship and other benefits
3. With holding results.

PROGRAMMES OF STUDY AND

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

PROGRAMMES OFFERED:

1. Higher Secondary Arts
2. Three Years Degree Programmes in Arts

The following documents must be produced at the time of admission

1. Original Marksheet, Pass Certificate Registration Certificate of the last qualifying examination.
2. Certificate of the Head of the Institution last attended
3. Two Copies of recent passport size photographs
4. Original Caste Certificate (issued by District Administrative Authority, viz. DC/SDC) for admission against caste quota. Provisional certificates will not be considered.
5. Proficiency Certificates of extra-curricular activities
6. Students who have passed the qualifying examination earlier than the current session need to submit a gap certificate for the period from the Head of the Institution last attended.
7. In case of migrating from another University or Board, Migration Certificate has to be produced
8. H.S. and T.D.C First Year students who fail to get promoted to the next higher class may apply for admission along with fresh application.
9. Gap Certificate (if necessary) only from Head of the institution last attended or affidavit from the Honourable Court in Assam or any other State.
10. Admission Committee may refuse admission to a candidate whose documents are not genuine or not found to be in proper order.
11. The college allots seats in HS and TDC programmes to students with outstanding performance in the field of sports, culture and NCC. These are allotted on the basis of merit cum proficiency in the field concerned. A few seats are also reserved for differently abled students.

Admission to the College is strictly on merit. **No application will be accepted after the stipulated last date of submission unless the College authority extends the last date for the same.** All admissions to the College are provisional and subject to approval of the Gauhati University/ Assam Higher Secondary Education Council. The College shall not be held responsible for GU/AHSEC not approving the admission of the student on various grounds such as not producing the migration certificate, eligibility certificate or furnishing false statements or the likes. The College shall not be held responsible for the problems in registration procedure in GU/AHSEC due to delay in submission of application forms on part of the student.

N.B. Maximum intake per subject is 150 students and that will be on the basis of merit.

Admission of Unsuccessful Candidates:

- ♦ H.S 1st year and T.D.C.(1st and 2nd Semesters) Students detained during Pre-final/Test Examination or declared discollegiate need to apply for admission along with the fresh applicants. However, no preference may be availed by such candidates regarding admission in the College.
- ♦ Students detained in the same class for two consecutive years in H.S. and three consecutive years in T.D.C. programmes will not be eligible for admission to the regular programmes in the College.

The Unsuccessful candidates of T.D.C. (1st and 2nd Semester) & (3rd and 4th Semester) Examination of Gauhati University appearing from the college need to enroll their names as regular students of T.D.C. (3rd and 4th Semester) & (5th and 6th Semester) classes respectively as notified by the College Authority.

LIBRARY RULES

All Students of the college are members of the college library by virtue of the library fees they pay along with tuition fees. Every student using the library will be given library cards in the following manner:

H.S. and Degree (core) – 01

Degree Major Courses - 02

Students will be entitled to keep books for **two weeks**, i.e., fourteen days from the date of issue and it shall be returned to the library at the end of the period. There is provision of re-issue of the same book to the same person if it is not wanted by someone else in which case the book may be retained for a period of another one week. The librarian may recall a book at any time. A student failing to return a book on due date will be levied a fine of Rs. 1/- per book for each consecutive day beyond the due date

A student who wishes to borrow a book shall fill in lending slip which will be provided at the counter of the library free of cost and present it at the issue counter along with the library card.

A student is not entitled to borrow a book against the library card of another person. If detected, he/she will be punished and/or fined.

Final Year/Semester students must return their library books along with the library cards before collecting their Admit Card of the Final Examination.

Strict silence and decorum should be maintained in the library. Students shall have to **switch-off** their mobile phones while at the library. Books have to be replaced if lost or damaged. Students found mutilating library books or periodicals or journals or magazines will be subject to disciplinary action. The college Library is open on all the working days of the college from 10.00 a.m. to 04.00 p.m.



SCHOLARSHIPS NAD AWARDS

(A) SCHOLARSHIPS

There is a scholarship section in the College Office which particularly handles all the matters related to scholarships. Generally, following categories of scholarships may be availed by meritorious students after approval from the respective authorities:

1. National Scholarships.

Scholarship facilities are subject to amendment as per respective orders received from State or Central Govt. Scholars are required to observe strict discipline and also be regular in class attendance and maintain sound academic performance during the scholarship period, failing which their scholarship may be withdrawn.

(B) Awards

1. Gold Medal is awarded to students securing first class in Major and General Degree courses
2. Cash prize is awarded to students securing 60% and above marks in Higher secondary Final Examination conducted by AHSEC.
3. Gold Medal is awarded to students of the college securing highest marks in any subject in the Higher Secondary Final Examination.
4. Students securing First Division are exempted from tuition fees on the schedule date of admission.
